CONSORTEX is a project funded by the Interreg Atlantic Area Programme, that aims to form at least five export consortia consisting of European interregional SMEs who specialise in the manufacture of certain built-in packages for marine vessels and structures (bridge, engine room, accommodation and deck) including offshore vessels, marine power plants, cruise ships, scientific vessels and naval.

WHY AN EXPORT CONSORTIUM?

An export consortium is composed of a group of companies that aims to promote their exports, through synergistic and joint actions. By being part of an export consortium, firms keep their autonomy and could combine expertise and financial means to access foreign markets.
